Our Next Meeting ... Cloning: the Road to Dolly (and the choices ahead)

In February 97 the world was electrified by the announcement that a sheep had been cloned from DNA from adult tissue. A scientific achievement recently declared technically impossible was accomplished by a virtually unknown scientist from Scotland. The questions began : could this technique work for humans? Should we be trying? Could this lead to an availability of cloned tissue available for transplantation, or to armies of identical clones suitable for the less pleasant tasks of society? Would they have souls, or rights? Can we now, as one prominent scientist put it, "control our own evolution" and thus better the human race? Is this a miracle for which to thank God, or an ominous new way to play God ourselves?

Dr. Linda Walkup, a molecular biologist, will present the history of and the latest reports on the controversy, including some proposed uses of cloned embryos that reflect the evolution-based value systems of many scientists.
