Follow up on Dr. Hugh Ross Meetings

On Sunday evening, April 11, Dr. Hugh Ross spoke at Hoffmantown Church on "The Reliability of Scripture." Considering the title, we would expect Biblical information in the context of the Bible that agrees with science. What we observed was a discussion of his view of science supported by taking scripture out of context. We have a concern with his use of biblically erroneous teachings and his view of secular science that appears to be elevated above the Bible. Some of the specific concerns are:

- (1) Dr. Ross teaches that the earth is approximately 4.6 billion years old. His only Biblical evidence for this is the absence of any statement between Genesis 2:3 and 2:4.
- (2) Dr. Ross also teaches that starting about 2-4 million years ago, God began to create man-like mammals or hominids without a soul, before Adam and Eve were created.
- (3) Romans 5:12 and 8:19 say death is a result of sin and "creation groans and suffers". Dr. Ross teaches animal death preceded Adam and Eve's sin for millions of years. Jerry Coryell President, Creation Science Fellowship
